Business Challenge

As City of Newton's "one woman IT department," Information Technology Manager Brenda Ternes is responsible for supporting more than 200 city employees while protecting the city's data and infrastructure. Working alone, whatever time she spent on managing security was unavailable for other important tasks. And, running Symantec's endpoints alongside other vendors' firewalls and spam filters, she was spending far too much time managing security.

"I was really frustrated with Symantec," says Ternes. "They couldn't get our licensing right, or anything else. We couldn't get good support, and the product wasn't user friendly. What's more, it was slow. When it would start scanning, it used too many resources. Users were complaining. Meanwhile, GFI's email filter was starting to let too much spam through, and people were starting to complain about that, too."

"One day, Sophos called to discuss its solution, and I liked all I heard. I spoke to colleagues who were using Sophos, and they were very pleased. I decided, this has to be better than what I'm using now. There's no reason not to try it."



Technology Solution

First, Ternes replaced Symantec's AV with Sophos' endpoint protection. "Deploying Sophos was a breeze. I was inexperienced then, but I did it all myself on a live production server. It just worked. I even taught my mentor, because his other clients started buying Sophos."

Performance improved, says Ternes: "Unlike Symantec, Sophos requires few system resources." Management improved, too. "The centralized management console is very user friendly. You can do everything from there. It's so much simpler, and I barely have to look at it daily to know I'm protected."

Next, Ternes invested in the Sophos Complete Security Suite for Government. Consolidating on Sophos gave her many opportunities to add value or reduce cost. First, she installed Sophos PureMessage to replace GFI's spam filter. "Sophos cut our spam greatly. I stopped buying GFI's support, saving about \$400 per year -- and saving lots of time in not having to answer complaints, or search the filter for valid items that were caught."

"I really like that you can just right-click, choose Protect Computers, and voilà, it takes care of everything. It's so easy."

Ternes also appreciated the home user licenses included with Sophos' suite. "Employees often ask me to support their personal systems. I can put home licenses on those PCs. They save time and money, and get better protection."

Ternes recently implemented Sophos' web filter as a virtual appliance on VMware -- again, without any help. "I'd been looking for a solution like that, when my Account Executive, Tyson Chartier, told me it's included in my suite. That saved me roughly \$6,000."

"I love this product. It sees users, what they're looking at, and the bandwidth they're using. And it's Terminal Services aware: if you're on Citrix, it records your user information instead of just the day's first connected user, or an IP address. Now I can tell a department head, 'this dude is streaming CBS movies, and I doubt that relates to his job.'"
